KANONKOP WINE ESTATE

Kanonkop Estate is arguably South Africa's leading red wine estate. At the 2008 International Wine and Spirit Competition held in London, Kanonkop won the Wolff Blass Trophy for International Winemaker of the Year, the Pichon Longueville Trophy for best blended red wine (3rd time!) and the Dave Hughes Trophy for best South African Producer.

REYNEKE WINE ESTATE



Reyneke wines are pioneers in South African farming and have moved from conventional farming to farming organically and finally to farming and producing their wines in accordance with biodynamic principles. The Owner, Johann Reyneke is currently one of only a few winemakers in SA who produce biodynamic wines and is considered somewhat of a ground-breaker in this regard.



WARWICK WINE ESTATE

The Warwick vineyards stretch up the mountain slopes in the Capes premier red wine valley, Muldersvlei. Years of working in various Bordeaux wineries has shaped the wine philosophy which prevails today with the classic French varieties, Merlot and Cabernet Franc dominating their production. The estate is very focused on the crafting of handmade wines, meticulous clonal selection, a controlled quality crop and minimal interference in the natural production process.



DE TRAFFORD WINES

De Trafford Winery is situated on the beautiful Mont Fleur farm set at the top of a dramatic valley above Stellenbosch, 380 metres up between the Stellenbosch and Helderberg mountains. The property is owned and run by the Trafford family with a small team of dedicated workers who take great care to produce properly ripe fruit from well balanced, manicured vineyards. All wines are fermented with natural yeasts, pressed with a traditional basket press and allowed to develop with the minimum of handling in small oak barrels before being bottled (most often) unfiltered.



RUST EN VREDE ESTATE

First family-owned wine farm to specialize in the exclusive production of quality red wine only, Rust en Vrede is now South Africa's Premium red wine Estate. Our full-bodied, oak matured wines are a manifestation of the supremacy of the Stellenbosch region when it comes to the making of truly great red wines. All our vines are of virus free clone material and grapes are hand selected and picked at optimum ripeness. We have been producing quality wines since 1979 and house the first underground cellar in the country.

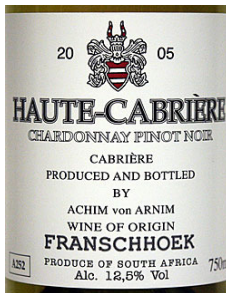

BOEKENHOUTSKLOOF WINE

Boekenhoutskloof is the magical little wine farm, which raised the bar (and some of their more conventional neighbour's eyebrows) when it comes to creating some of the country's finest wines. It is also where these four much-loved brands are produced: Boekenhoutskloof, The Chocolate Block, Porcupine Ridge and The Wolftrap. Boekenhoutskloof has opted out of award seeking. "We simply don't have the volume to enter shows," "Anyway, we'll find the people who appreciate our wines, or they'll find us and that is all that matters."

CABRIERE WINES



Home of Pierre Jourdan and Haute Cabriere wines, the beautiful Cabriere, situated on the banks of the Franschhoek river. Achim von Arnim's decades old belief is that wine is grown not made. The essence of his philosophy is proclaimed on a pillar carrying a sundial in the vineyards: "Sun, Soil, Vine, Man" The Haute Cabriere cellar is specially designed to handle Pinot Noir, the most fragile, delicate and demanding cultivar. The process of harvesting is totally gravity fed. The grapes enter through the roof of the cellar, the juice from crushing to pressing to filling the fermentation tanks, gently flows by its own gravity three storeys deep to the bottom of the mountain cellar.

L'ORMARINS



From its home base on historic L'Ormarins wine farm beneath the jagged peaks of the Groot Drakenstein mountain in Franschhoek, Anthonij Rupert Wines has cast its net wide, across the length and breadth of the Cape winelands, in search of what it takes to make the finest wines this corner of the winemaking world has to offer. The vines grow in terraced vineyards at various altitudes and on a variety of mountain slopes, thus producing interesting variations in yield and character.
